2ND ANNUAL TREK DES TREES

TREK DES TREES is an annual bike ride dedicated to raising the awareness and need for tree education in our communities. Choose between:

1. A **group long ride** which will roll through the Champlain Valley through Burlington and surrounding towns. The group pace will average 15-18 mph depending on the skill level of the riders and approximately cover a distance of 35-50 miles.

2. Second Annual Educational **Bike Rally**. Riders will see sights of Burlington along the bike path while answering tree and local community related questions with a team of 4 riders.

What is a Bike Rally? Rallies are similar to scavenger hunts except teams are usually gathered to solve questions or tasks together. The Rally covers a distance of 10 kilometers (or 6.2 miles) on the Burlington bike path. The ride is designed to accommodate any ability of rider. At very leisurely pace and with ample time given to complete the ride, each team will answer tree and local community questions! The goal is to have your team answer the most correct questions in the shortest period of time.

You may register as a team or as an individual. Individuals will be placed on a team the morning of the event. Registration will be limited to 10 teams of four. The morning of the Rally each team will be given a bicycle basket of your Rally adventure needs. With the aid of a map each team will navigate the Rally course route to find designated Rally stops. Typically the stops are at trees, historic markers, parks, or points of interest. At each location, questions or tasks await your team, and if completed correctly you earn points. Your

bicycle basket contains all the materials you will need to complete the tasks. All answers should be recorded in your designated answer book. The team who completes the ride in the shortest amount of time and who accumulates the most points wins!

Points will be tallied and prizes will be given for:

- **Team with most points and shortest ride time**
- **Most correctly answered "tree" questions**
- **Most correctly answered "local" questions**
- **Best team name**
- **Best team spirit**

The Trek registration will begin at 8:30 am at the Upper Pavilion Picnic Area at Oakledge Park, Pine Street, Burlington, VT.

For riders' safety bike helmets *must* be worn. The ride will be held rain or shine! Come join the fun!
